### The International Year of Glass Inspired Us to Create Programs to Celebrate Glass Science in 2022

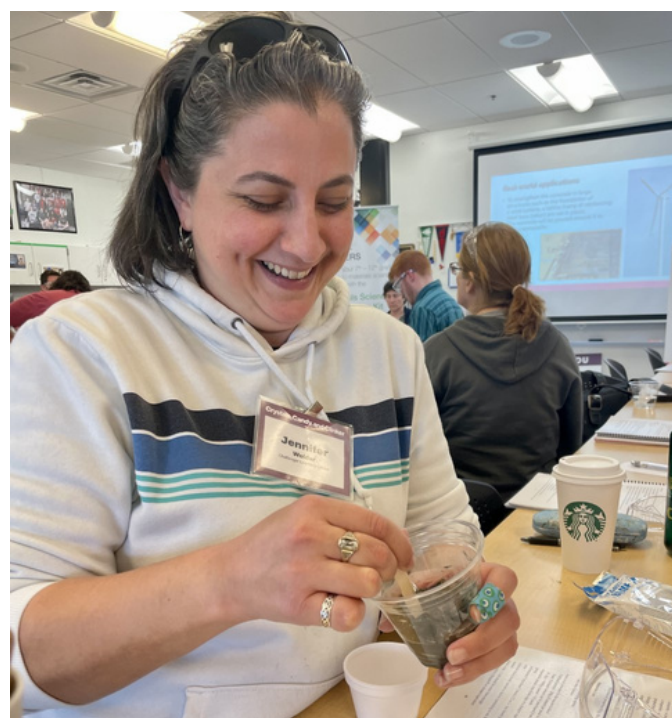
- January 2022:** The United Nations declares 2022 as the International Year of Glass.
- May 2022:** CGIF showcases hands-on glass demonstrations at COSI's Big Science Celebration to 25,000 attendees.
- June 2022:** CGIF partners with GOMD to teach the science behind the art of glassblowing to Baltimore high school students.
- August 2022:** CGIF announces a new Glass Science Kit to expand learning about glass science in middle and high school classrooms.
- October 2022:** At MS&T 2022, CGIF launches the Glass Learning Opportunities Workshop (GLOW) at the Pittsburgh Glass Center.

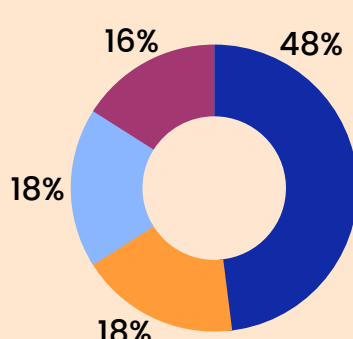

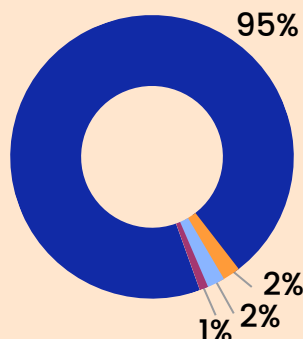
